The system consists of four 3" landscape/deck mountable satellites, one 10" dual voice coil subwoofer, and all mounting hardware and direct burial cables. The subwoofer is available in above ground or below ground versions. All speakers are water resistant and have been treated with U/V protection.

SHORT SHOTS

FROM DEALERS AND REPS

Richt Teo of Sound and Video Professional (SV-Pro), Singapore informed us of several install success stories of projects he has completed using OAP Products. In October 2002 SV-Pro successfully finished St. Anthony's Church in Singapore using (4) *Q-2500SE* for the main house system and (3) *Q-1200CEs* for the delay cluster along with (2) units of *T-102s* as flyable stage monitors and (4) *NF-80s* for under the balcony. Another install they completed was St. Hilda's School Hall, Singapore using (4) *T-152s* for the front of the stage with an additional (2) for the rear delay coverage while (2) *SM-112s* were used as floor monitors. The system was installed into a school assembly room and the Principal was very pleased with the system. August 2003 SV-Pro installed (8) *NF-281s*, which were distributed evenly in a fan shape design into Marine Parade Seminary Classroom in Singapore. The owner was satisfied and said, "the loudspeaker system was clear and sonically pleasant to hear." In January 2004 SV-Pro completed an install for the University of Sabah, Malaysia using (10) *C-3s* in five universities lecturing theaters installed in a fan shape design. The owner was so happy with the capability of the OAP loudspeaker system and SV-Pro's after sales support that they ordered an additional (4) *Q-2200s* for the universities hall of 300 seats. June of 2004 they completed Heartroth Pubs in Indonesia and used (6) *Q-2200s* and (2) *TR-215s* underneath the stage along with (4) *SM-122*

floor monitors. (2) *Q-2200* were rigged in a cluster for the front left and right with a delay unit of (2) *T-102s* for the rear seats. The pub caters to young adults with live band performances and karaoke. The owner of the pub was extremely impressed with the performance of the loudspeakers.



Cathy Shanahan of Shanahan Sound & Electronics Lowell, MA recently installed *C-2* loudspeakers into Hope Community Church in Newburyport, MA. This design and installation was featured in *Church Production Magazine*.

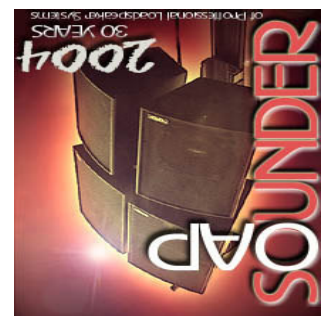
